Keynote 1: State Vision for Technology Start-ups, Addressing Start-up challenges and building ecosystem

The keynote stage of India first tech startup conclave & awards then witnessed an interactive keynote session that featured various State representatives who shared about the startup ecosystem of their respective states, growth, challenges, and solutions with an interactive crowd.
